ORDINANCE NO. 2018-10

AN ORDINANCE

ENGAGING MARK MARONG AND KIRK HENRIKSON OF MATTY, HENRIKSON & GREVE CO., L.P.A., TO PROVIDE SPECIAL COUNSEL TO ORANGE VILLAGE IN WORKERS COMPENSATION RELATED MATTERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council has the authority to engage special counsel to provide legal services on behalf of Orange Village; and

WHEREAS, this Council determines it is necessary to engage special counsel to represent Orange Village in administrative proceedings and court actions in workers compensation related matters; and

WHEREAS, the Law Director has recommended the engagement of Mark Marong and Kirk Henrikson of Matty, Henrikson & Greve Co. L.P.A. to perform the aforesaid services required of special counsel; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Mark Marong and Kirk Henrikson of Matty, Henrikson & Greve Co. L.P.A. ("Special Counsel") are engaged as special counsel to Orange Village, to represent the Village in administrative proceedings and court actions in workers compensation related matters.

SECTION 2. The Village will pay Special Counsel at the rate of \$175 per hour for services provided by an attorney and \$115 per hour for services provided by a paralegal. At the conclusion of the tax year provided for herein, the Village shall issue Special Counsel the tax form known as a "1099," or equivalent tax reporting form as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Orange Village and, further, provides for the immediate engagement of counsel to represent the Village in administrative proceedings and legal actions related to workers

compensation matters; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
