**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-25**

**AN ORDINANCE  
TRANSFERRING FUNDS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS.**

WHEREAS, Village Council finds and determines that it is necessary to transfer and appropriate funds in order to provide for the daily operation of the Village and capital improvement projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That \$2,053.59 be transferred from the General Fund (101) of the Village to the Capital Improvement Fund (401) of the Village and such funds are hereby appropriated.

SECTION 2. That \$92,500.00 be transferred from the General Fund (101) of the Village to the Police Pension Fund (207) of the Village and such funds are hereby appropriated.

SECTION 3. That \$119,250.00 be transferred from the General Fund (101) of the Village to the Capital Equipment Fund (402) of the Village and such funds are hereby appropriated.


SECTION 4. That \$4,692.46 be transferred from the General Fund (101) of the Village to the Trust & Agency Funds (701) of the Village and such funds are hereby appropriated.

SECTION 5. That any ordinance, or any portion of any ordinance, which conflicts with this ordinance is repealed in order to eliminate the conflict.

SECTION 6. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 7. That, pursuant to Article III, Section 11(a) of the Charter of Orange Village, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its signature by the Mayor, upon the expiration of the time within which it may be vetoed by the Mayor, or upon its passage after it has been vetoed by the Mayor, as the case may be.
