ORDINANCE NO. 2017-16

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CUYAHOGA COUNTY FOR THE CONTINUED MAINTENANCE OF VILLAGE-OWNED STORM AND SANITARY SEWERS.

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County and Orange Village have an existing agreement whereby the County maintains the Village's sanitary sewer lines; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to renew and revise the existing contractual relationship and to allow the Village to receive storm sewer maintenance services, if the Village deems it beneficial; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the renewed and revised agreement with the County for sewer maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into the Utility Agreement Between County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, and Orange Village, Ohio (the "Agreement"), a draft of which is appended hereto as "Exhibit A." The Agreement may be modified by the Mayor and the Law Director in any manner that is not adverse to the interests of Orange Village.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute all other documents and provide all other information necessary or helpful in order to perform the Village's obligations under the Agreement.

SECTION 3. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
