## **ORDINANCE NO. 2017-7**

## AN ORDINANCE

REPEALING SECTION 147.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF ORANGE VILLAGE TO REPEAL THE BOND REQUIREMENT FOR VILLAGE EMPLOYEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council desires to repeal the bond requirements of Section 147.01 of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village because such requirements are redundant insurance coverages for the risk of loss or theft that the Village might face, the requirements do not provide material protection to the Village relative to the risks faced by the Village, and the bond requirements impose some cost on the Village which are not warranted by the benefits obtained by the Village in exchange for that cost.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That existing Section 147.01, and all ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, are repealed.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that each and every formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance was taken in any open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in each such formal action, were conducted in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 105 of the Orange Village Codified Ordinances.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Orange Village and, further, provides an immediate cost savings for the Village of a duplicate insurance protection for the Village; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
