ORDINANCE NO. 2019-25

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AND GRANTING CONSENT TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO UNDERTAKE THE WIDENING OF CHAGRIN BOULEVARD (SR-87) NORTH SIDE PAVEMENT BETWEEN ORANGE PLACE AND BRAINARD ROAD IN THE VILLAGE OF ORANGE AND WOODMERE AND INVOLVING THE CITY OF BEACHWOOD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I – Project Description (Preamble)

WHEREAS, The STATE has identified the need for the described project:

The widening of Chagrin Boulevard (SR-87) north side pavement between Orange Place and Brainard Road in the Village of Orange and Woodmere and involving the City of Beachwood.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Orange Village, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

SECTION II – Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the Council of Orange Village gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III – Cooperation Statement

Orange Village shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The entire cost and expense of this improvement will be provided by the Department. No financial participation will be required by Orange Village.

Orange Village agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by Orange Village which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

SECTION IV – Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The Council of Orange Village agrees to acquire and/or make available to ODOT, in accordance with current State and Federal Regulations, all necessary right-of-way required for the described Project. Orange Village also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs. Orange Village agrees to be responsible for all utility accommodation, relocation, and reimbursement and agrees that all such accommodations, relocations, and reimbursements shall comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Orange Village shall maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.


SECTION VI - Authority to Sign

Kathy U. Mulcahy, Mayor of Orange Village is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation which are necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION VII – Effective Date

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to expedite the highway project and to promote highway safety. Following appropriate legislative action, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


