A RESOLUTION

OF SUPPORT FOR EFFORTS TO SECURE CLEAN OHIO GREEN SPACE CONSERVATION **FUNDING** TO **PRESERVE** SIGNIFICANT GREEN SPACE LOCATED IN ORANGE VILLAGE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; it has come to the attention of Orange Village ("Village") that a certain property located south of Harvard Road, west of Brainard Road and east of the Chagrin Highlands (the "Property") has been offered for sale for development; and,

WHEREAS, the Village, in conjunction with the Chagrin River Watershed Partners, desires to apply for Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation funding to preserve all or a portion of the Property as permanent green space; and,

WHEREAS, Orange Village desires financial assistance under the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Public Works Commission, administers financial assistance for conservation purposes through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program ("Clean Ohio"); and

SECTION 2. That Council hereby supports the efforts to secure funding from the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation program; and

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Code of Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
