ORDINANCE NO. 2020-2

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING SUBSECTION 351.03(N) OF CHAPTER 351, PARKING GENERALLY, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF ORANGE VILLAGE, AND REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, this Council desires to prohibit stopping, standing or parking wherever the curbing or street has been designated as a fire lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That existing Subsection (n) of Section 351.03, Prohibited, Standing or Parking Places, of the Codified Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"351.03 PROHIBITED STANDING OR PARKING PLACES.

No person shall stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to comply with the provisions of this Traffic Code, or while obeying the directions of a police officer or a traffic control device, in any of the following places:

(n) At any place where signs prohibit stopping, standing or parking, or where the curbing or street is painted yellow marked by paint as a designated fire lane, or at any place in excess of the maximum time limited by signs;

SECTION 2. That existing subsection (n) of Section 351.03, of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village and any ordinance or any part of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village.

<u>SECTION 4</u> . That this Ordinance shall	take effect and be in force from and after the
earliest period allowed by law.
