



COVID-19 Policy – Landscaping Service

In furtherance of the Order of the Ohio Director of the Department of Health, issued March 22, 2020 (the “Order”), Orange Village has adopted the following policy for the provision of landscaping services in the Village.

- **Landscapers must keep minimum six (6) feet distances while working and when communicating with each other**
 - **Landscapers must individually travel to work sites alone**
1. Landscapers may provide grass cutting, maintenance and emergency tree maintenance services within Orange Village pursuant to the Order. New landscape construction, installation, (e.g., decks, walls, etc.) not deemed essential are not permitted.
 2. Landscapers must comply with the social distancing requirements of the Order. This means that landscapers **must** travel to work sites individually so as not to be in close proximity to each other (e.g. not in the same personal or service vehicle) and must keep appropriate minimum six (6) feet distances while working and when communicating with each other, residents and other members of the public when at a residence or commercial property.
 3. All Landscapers are required to wipe down and sanitize any hard surfaces of the customer (including customer’s doorbells, doorknobs, customer’s equipment or other property, and excluding driveways, walkways or pavement) which landscape personnel have touched with their hands when at the work site.
 4. Landscapers will be responsible for determining the health of the landscaping personnel. Landscapers shall not allow personnel demonstrating any symptom of Covid 19, including cough, fever or shortness of breath, to appear or work at the worksite.
 5. Landscapers must continue to comply with all other laws in the Village, including Chapter 1329, which requires landscapers to have a valid license to provide landscaping services in the Village.
 6. Failure to comply with this policy shall result in the revocation of the landscaper’s license, upon the Building Commission making a finding that the landscaper has violated any ordinance of the Village, law of the State or rules and regulations of the Village. Such a revocation of a permit would prevent the landscaper from performing such services in the Village.
