

**A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE
CUYAHOGA SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
AND THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT.**

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding has been proposed between the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District and the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District and Orange Village ("Memorandum"); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Memorandum is to implement conservation education, stewardship, and public involvement activities that also correspond to the Village's Municipal Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit; and

WHEREAS, this Council desire to authorize the Mayor to enter into the Memorandum.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Memorandum of Understanding between the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District and the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District and Orange Village, a copy of which is appended to this ordinance, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution, and the attached Memorandum of Understanding between the Cuyahoga County Soil and Water Conservation District and Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District and Orange Village.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Code of Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
