## **ORDINANCE NO. 2021-6**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE CLERK OF COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article III, Section 10 of the Charter of Orange Village the Clerk of Council is an employee of Council and Council has the authority to establish the pay of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, Council has, by motion, adjusted the pay of the Clerk of Council within a range that had been previously established, but Council finds and determines that it is now time to adjust the range of pay for the Clerk of Council.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That effective January 1, 2021, the Clerk of Council shall be paid a stipend of \$500 per month, payable monthly. Council may, by motion, amend the compensation of the Clerk of Council to an amount that is within a range that is between \$300 and \$600 per month. The stipend shall be earnable wages for OPERS purposes and shall be reported on the Clerk of Council's W-2 statement of earnings.

SECTION 2. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Orange Village and, further, provides for the usual daily operation of the Council Clerk's office; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
