

**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-17
(AS AMENDED)**

**AN ORDINANCE
PROVIDING COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN VILLAGE
EMPLOYEES, REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, this Council desires to set the pay ranges for certain Village Employees, subject to the administration of such ranges by the Mayor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That, effective January 1, 2022, the following ranges of compensation for full-time employees be and are hereby established as follows:



SECTION 3. That any ordinance or part thereof in conflict herewith be and is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Orange Village and, further, this ordinance provides for the timely compensation of valuable Village employees; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


