A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVANCE TAXES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County be and hereby is requested to advance all tax revenues collected in the year 2022, which will cover the first and last half of 2021 real estate collections as well as special assessments made for the Orange Place extension project, the Lander Road waterline project, and the Emery Road waterline project.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That the Clerk of Council is directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County.

SECTION 3. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Code of Ordinances of Orange Village.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to advance such taxes in order that Orange Village will have funds for the daily operation of business; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
