It will have 2 bedrooms and 2.5 bathrooms with a flex room, sunroom and a fireplace. There is a vaulted ceiling in the gathering room. #5 PINECREST – BUILDING #1 – WHOLD FOODS (50 WALL STREET) CHARGING STATIONS .

PZ/ABR Discussion:

The project was not approved by the Village Engineer. Mr. Greg Brenner has already met with First Energy and has been in contact with the Village Engineer to address his comments. The new charging stations would be replacing the existing charging stations. The plans as originally submitted showed the charging stations on the south west corner of the parking lot. That placement would require a zoning variance. WB Engineers resubmitted the plans showing the charging stations in a different location within the setback requirements. Mr. Larry Genova of the Orange Village Fire Department reviewed the plans and prefers the charging stations in the original placement of the south west corner of the parking lot. He stated it would be easier to fight a lithium battery fire. Mr. Brenner stated they have determined there is a gas easement in the south west corner of the parking lot and the charging stations cannot be placed in that location. A discussion ensued about placing the charging stations in different locations. Mr. Brian Hitt stated that Mr. Bob McLaughlin, Mr. Brenner and Whole Foods will need to talk and come up with solutions. He stated the matter has been tabled.
