Chief Wilson explained the fire department formed a committee 6 months ago, we will be using the same company we had in the past. The lead time is between 475-500 days. This item was budgeted for 2023 and we have been accumulating the funds over the past few years. We do not have to pay until the vehicle is delivered. Mrs. Perry stated that the Finance Committee unanimously recommended the purchase of the ambulance.

**A. ORDINANCE 2022-6**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF ORANGE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION WINTER CONTRACT (018-23) FOR ROAD SALT AND TO TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BULK PURCHASING OF ROAD SALT FOR THE 2022-2023 WINTER SEASON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 1<sup>st</sup> Reading

**B. ORDINANCE 2022-7**

**Kline**


- P & Z meeting update - Pulte currently has 3 lots left in Lakes of Orange, rezoning for new charging stations at Whole Foods

- Wished Sgt. Debeljak a speedy recovery in body and spirit


