

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-4

**A RESOLUTION
APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF THE CUYAHOGA
COUNTY 2022-2027 ALL-HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Orange Village, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, is vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, Orange Village acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the Orange Village; and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Orange Village does hereby adopt the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan for Orange Village, which Plan shall be kept on file in Village Hall.

SECTION 2. That the respective officials identified in the implementation strategy of the Cuyahoga County 2022-2027 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council

and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Code of Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that the timely adoption of the plan is needed to provide for the public health, safety and welfare in the event of a natural hazard; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.


