ORDINANCE NO. 2022-21

**AN ORDINANCE
 AMENDING SECTION 933.01(B) TO REVISE THE FEES TO BE
 CHARGED TO RESIDENTS AND NON-RESIDENTS FOR
 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, REPEALING CERTAIN
 ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village has a continuing interest in collecting fees from users of the Village’s Emergency Medical Service; and

WHEREAS, the Village has a continuing interest in establishing appropriate charges and credits for users of the Village Emergency Medical Service; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that there is a need to amend the schedule of fees and credits to be applied to the users of the Village’s Emergency Medical Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That existing subsection (b) of Section 933.01, Provision of Emergency Medical Services; Charges, of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Orange, be and the same hereby is amended to read and provide, in its entirety, as follows:

“933.01 PROVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE; CHARGES

(b) The charge or fee to be paid shall be the same for both residents and nonresidents of the Village as follows (classification of service shall be determined by the Orange Village Fire Department):

| (3) Advanced Life Support (2) | \$750.00 | \$1,200 |

Additionally, a mileage charge of ~~twelve~~ **sixteen** dollars (~~\$12~~**\$16**) per mile traveled outside of the municipal corporation limits shall be levied for the transportation of a patient to a medical facility.

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SECTION 2. That existing subsection (b) of Section 933.01, Provision of Emergency Medical Service; Charges, of the Code of Ordinances of the Village, is repealed.

SECTION 3. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council

and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of Orange Village, to continue to defray the costs of providing emergency medical services, and to have a date certain for the commencement of the levying of the new and appropriate fees for services; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and its approval by the Mayor, or as otherwise provided by law.


