#### PZ/ABR Discussion:

The project has been approved by the Village Architect was not approved by the Village Engineer. Ms. Ann Dunning is having the updated site plan prepared and will resubmit to the Village Engineer for review. Both Ms. Dunning and the Village Engineer do not have any concerns about the updated site plan per Mr. Bob McLaughlin. The two (2) story addition is approximately 520 square feet. ## PZ/ABR Discussion:

The pavilion will be 12' x 12' and made of trex decking material with a black aluminum railing. The trim will be white. The shingles will match the existing on the house. The pavilion will be wrapped in azek material with a pine ceiling. Ms. Kathy Moran stated the pavilion can be built in to the house. Mr. David Pfeiffer said they don't typically build in to the house. Mr. Jud Kline said there are no gutters shown on the plan and there will more water shedding off the roof than you expect. He recommends adding gutters. Mr. Randy Devaul said he will defer to Woodland Deck and the Board. He also stated if the rain is heavy, they will be in the house. Ms. Moran inquired what will be under the deck. Mr. Devaul said when he gets the landscaping done, they will install gravel under the deck. He also said there will be plantings around the pavilion.

A Joint Motion was made to approve the pavilion and deck at 522 Silver Lake Drive with the recommendation there be gutters installed at a later date as determined by the homeowner was made by Mr. Jud Kline; Seconded by Mrs. Amanda Kurland.
