

**A RESOLUTION  
VOTING FOR A MAYORAL REPRESENTATIVE ON  
THE 9-1-1 PROGRAM REVIEW COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, Orange Village is located within the County of Cuyahoga and is therefore part of Cuyahoga County's 9-1-1 service network; and

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County convenes a 9-1-1 Program Review Committee in accordance with Ohio Revised Code, Section 128.06 (B); and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, Section 128.06 (B) (4) specifies that all municipal corporations within Cuyahoga County are entitled to one vote as to the chief executive officer of one municipal corporation, who shall represent on the 9-1-1 Program Review Committee all chief executive officers of all municipal corporations within Cuyahoga County; and

WHEREAS, said representative shall be selected by the majority of the legislative authorities of municipal corporations in Cuyahoga County.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That Mayor Kirsten Holzheimer Gail of Euclid, Ohio is hereby nominated and voted to serve on Cuyahoga County's 9-1-1 Program Review Committee as the representative of all chief executive officers of all municipal corporations within Cuyahoga County.

SECTION 2. That the Council has determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council in compliance with Ohio law, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were open to the public when required by Ohio law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.


