**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-16**

**AN ORDINANCE  
ENACTING A NEW SECTION 125.26, OHIO EPA GRANT FUND, OF  
CHAPTER 125, TREASURER, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF  
ORANGE VILLAGE TO PROVIDE FOR THE UTILIZATION OF AN  
OHIO EPA GRANT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Orange Village has been awarded an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (“Ohio EPA”) grant and needs to account for such grants with a separate fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That existing Chapter 125, Treasurer, of the Codified Ordinances of Orange Village, Ohio, is amended to provide for the enactment of a new Section 125.26 which shall provide as follows:

**“125.26 OHIO EPA GRANT FUND.**

There is hereby created a special fund to be known as the Ohio EPA Grant Fund. All funds received from the Ohio EPA Grant Fund shall be deposited into this fund and expended for proper and authorized grant purposes. The Treasurer is authorized and directed to make application to the Auditor of State for the approval of the creation of the Ohio EPA Grant Fund in accordance with Ohio R.C. 5705.12.”

SECTION 2. That upon its passage, the Clerk of Council shall forthwith transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer, 2079 East Ninth Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44115 and to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management, 30 E. Broad Street, Suite 34, Columbus, Ohio 43215

SECTION 3. That all Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the law.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the

inhabitants of Orange Village, and for the reason that it is necessary to immediately receive and account for funding that is being provided by the Ohio EPA; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and its approval by the Mayor, or as otherwise provided by law.


