

**A RESOLUTION  
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING MAYOR JUDSON A.  
KLINE OF ORANGE VILLAGE TO COMPLETE ALL  
ACTIONS NECESSARY TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION  
FOR THE 2025 CUYAHOGA COUNTY COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the County of Cuyahoga, through the Community Development Department, offers a competitive grant that makes awards to help strengthen communities, encourage regional collaboration, and improve quality of life for county residents; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Development Supplemental Grant (“CDSG”) Program will help the Village enforce and maintain its traffic laws, thereby making the Village an even safer community.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF ORANGE VILLAGE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby supports the efforts to secure funding from the 2025 Cuyahoga County Supplemental Grant Program.

SECTION 2. That this Council hereby authorizes and directs Mayor Judson A. Kline to prepare and submit an application to the Cuyahoga County Development Office, seeking the grant funds for the purpose of supporting Orange Village’s Traffic Calming Initiative, which will primarily consist of Solar-Powered Radar Speed Signs at various locations within the Village. The application is marked as “Exhibit A”, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3. That Mayor Judson A. Kline is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of Orange Village to execute all instruments and to take all steps necessary in connection with the preparation and submission of the application(s) and enter into any agreement(s) as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 4. That the actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 105 of the Code of Ordinances of Orange Village.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Orange Village, and further, for the reason that the CDSG Grant Agreement deadline is imminent; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.


